


DRINKS LIST

We have chosen to charge our customers a fixed ‘corkage’ on each bottle of wine we sell rather than apply a percentage margin that makes good wines unaffordable for most. SPARKLING WINES

125ml Bottle

Vigneau-Chevreau, Vouvray Brut Pétillant, France, NV £6.50 £23.50

100% Chenin Blanc

Flavours of apple and brioche, very fresh and a perfect aperitif. Pétillant means this sparkling is made in a slightly less fizzy style, which gives it a very creamy texture.

Alexander Filaine, Brut Speciale, Champagne, France, NV £41.00

45% Pinot Noir, 43% Chardonnay, 12% Pinot Meunier

Alexander Filaine worked at Bollinger, but today produces only around 4000 bottles a year under his own label. A rich champagne with brioche, mandarin & red apple.

SCOTTISH GINS & VODKA

35ml

Rock Rose Gin, Dunnet, 41.5% abv £4.00

Juniper driven gin distilled with a variety of berries, which gives the gin a lovely crispness.

Arbikie AK's Gin, Angus, 43% abv £4.00

A field-to-bottle gin, made with wheat grown at the Arbikie estate in Arbroath. A smooth and fresh gin with a touch of baking spices and honey.

Arbikie Potato Vodka, Angus, 43% abv £4.50

A field-to-bottle vodka, made with potatoes grown at the Arbikie estate in Arbroath. Extremely smooth and creamy vodka with pleasant floral and citrus flavours.

SCOTTISH BEERS

Bottle 330ml

Larger Keith, Keith Brewery, 4.5% abv £3.50

A big lager combining the freshness and lightness of a typical lager with slightly malty and toasty flavours.

Aurora, Windswept Brewery, 3.8% abv £3.50

Light golden ale with citrus fruit and a touch of herbal notes. Bottle conditioned.

Long Time IPA, Black Isle Brewery, 6.9% abv £4.00

An IPA & wheat beer hybrid, it has the typical cloudiness of wheat beer combined with IPA's tropical fruits flavours such as guava and a slightly bitter finish.

MacRobert's Reply, Windswept Brewery, 4.7% abv £3.50

Classic amber ale, malty, toasty and a hint of chocolate. Bottle conditioned.

Wolf, Windswept Brewery, 6.0% abv £4.00

Dark ale with rich flavours of coffee, chocolate and a touch of sweetness. Bottle conditioned.

WHITE WINES

Legado de Farro, Godello, Bierzo, Spain, 2016

£23.00

100% Godello

A great example of the godello grape with flavours of pear, apple and herbal character with pleasant slightly waxy texture. Every sauvignon blanc lover should try this!

Goianea, Uno, Txacoli de Alava, Spain, 2015

£24.50

97% Hondabarri Zuri, 3% Riesling

In 1999, there were only 5ha of Hondabarri grapes left in the Alava subregion. The wine shows why Alava is now considered the leading subregion in Txacoli. The wine has markedly fresh acidity, minerality, green apple, and white peach.

Nals Margreid, Penon, Alto Adige, Italy, 2016

£25.00

100% Pinot Bianco

Single vineyard pinot bianco grown near Bolzano in a warm climate and cool mountain winds produce small and concentrated grapes. The resulting wine is fresh with lemon, white peaches and a marked minerality. Very similar in style and drive to Chablis.

Fattoria Il Coroncino, Il Coroncino, Marche, Italy, 2016

£25.50

100% Verdicchio

Late harvest grapes are used to create a full-bodied wine with flavours of nectarine, ripe melon and almonds on the long finish.

Roagna, Langhe Bianco, Piedmonte, Italy, 2015

£27.50

80% Chardonnay, 20% Nebbiolo

Chardonnay blended with red grapes?! Yet, it really works: crushed stones, toast, citrus fruit all linger on the long finish. For all the chardonnay lovers out there!

Montmollin, Chasselas Non Filtré, Neuchâtel, Switzerland, 2017

£28.50

100% Chasselas

Unfiltered Chasselas is a specialty of Switzerland, released on the third Wednesday of every January. Very mineral palate with fresh peaches and a touch of apricot kernel.

Emmerich Knoll, Federspiel, Wachau, Austria, 2012

£31.00

100% Riesling

Bone dry riesling with a slightly chewy texture. Rich flavours of lemon peel, white flowers, peach, and minerality with added complexity from bottle aging.

Frank Cornelissen, Munjebel Bianco, Sicily, Italy, 2016

£42.00

60% Grecanico Dorado, 40% Carricante

Frank Cornelissen is a winemaking pioneer on Mount Etna and one of the most meticulous winemakers I have ever met. His white wine has complex and rich flavours of citrus fruit and melons. Fresh acidity and minerality thanks to the volcanic soils.

RED WINES

Bottle

Sepp Moser, Sepp, Burgenland, Austria, 2017

£23.00

100% Zweigelt

Zweigelt is the most planted red grape in Austria, and this wine shows why. This light-bodied wine shows juicy red cherries, blackberries and subtle spiciness.

Niepoort, Rotulo, Dao, Portugal, 2012

£23.50

Touriga Nacional, Jaen, Alfrocheiro

Fresh and crisp with flavours of blueberries and damsons. In the background you will note some mineral and spice flavours, typical characteristics of wines from Dao.

Domaine St. Germain, Les Taillis, Savoie, France, 2012

£26.00

100% Mondeuse Noir

Dark and intense with black pepper and smoky flavours. On the palate fresh red fruits, such as plums, cherries and lingonberries.

Kellerei Kurtatsch, Lagrein, Alto Adige, Italy, 2017

£26.50

100% Lagrein

This wine shows the full spectrum of flavours that are typical to lagrein: ripe red cherries, blackberries and violets with a touch of spices. The texture is velvety due to ripe tannins and balanced acidity.

Frank Cornelissen, Rosso del Contadino, Etna, Italy, 2016

£30.00

85% Nerello Mascalese, Nerello Cappuccio, Minella Nera, Alicante Bouschet, Minella Bianco

Frank Cornelissen is a winemaking pioneer on Mount Etna and one of the most meticulous winemakers I have ever met. The wine is light bodied with fresh red cherries, touch of leather, some herbal and earthy notes.

JL Chave Selection, St. Joseph, Rhone, France, 2011

£31.00

100% Syrah

A classic northern Rhone syrah from the region's superstar winemaker. The elegant wine shows dark berries, black pepper, violets, and a hint of smoked meat.

Tenuta Mara, Guiry, Emilia-Romagna, Italy, 2014

£32.50

100% Sangiovese

Just a cracking sangiovese! Sour cherry, raspberry and blackberry fruits are joined with ginger and star anise.

Enrico Esu, Seruci, Sardinia, Italy, 2015

£32.50

100% Carignan

Very rich and dark scented wine. Shows aromas of deep dark blackberry, raisins, black olives together with rosemary and thyme. Less than 2000 bottles produced every year.

Mee Godard, Cote du Puy, Morgon, Beaujolais, France, 2014 £34.00
100% Gamay

From a small parcel within the top cru of Morgon. A full-bodied and serious version of a Beaujolais. It shows floral, licorice and black fruit flavours laced with rocky tones.

Roagna, Langhe Nebbiolo, Piemonte, Italy, 2012 £36.00
100% Nebbiolo

The grapes come from two revered sites in Piemonte: Pira (Barolo) and Pajé (Barbaresco). Very traditional winemaking with long maceration and long aging (5 years) in large neutral oak barrels. Great typicity with high acidity and grippy ripe tannins with flavours of strawberry, rose petals, and spice box.

Tardieu-Laurent, Châteauneuf-du-Pape VV, Rhone, France, 2010 £46.50
85% Grenache, 10% Mourvedre, 5% Syrah

The grenache is picked from 80+ year old vines from the Crau area of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Richly flavoured and textured wine from one of the best vintages in Southern Rhone. Ripe blackberries and plums together with baking spices on the long finish.

SWEET WINE

70ml Bottle

Niepoort, Colheita 2005, Douro, Portugal (375ml bottle) £6.50 £26.50
Touriga National, Touriga Franca, Tinto Cao, and other native Douro grapes

A superb single vintage Tawny port. Aged for 8 years in small old oak casks. Shows dried fruit flavours, spiciness and toasted nuts. Great with cheese!

Heidi Schröck, Beerenauslese, Austria, 2015 (375ml bottle) £8.00 £34.50
Welschriesling & Weissburgunder

The wine is made with heavily botrytised grapes and shows intriguing aromas of mango, pineapple, and orange marmalade. The high acidity provides a perfect balance to the sweetness on the long lasting finish.

Dönnhoff, Oberhäuser Brücke Goldkap, Nahe, £36.00
Germany, 2003 (375ml bottle)

100% Riesling

From a famous single vineyard wholly owned by the Dönnhoff family. A superbly concentrated sweet riesling with high acidity keeping this wine very fresh and beautifully balanced. It shows a wide array of flavours including floral, citrus, and stone fruits together with honey, hay, and marmalade flavours from the extended bottle aging.

SCOTTISH WHISKY

35ml

Benromach Organic 2010, Forres, Speyside, 43% abv

£4.50

First organic single malt whisky produced in Scotland. Typical Speyside characters of vanilla, toffee and banana with coffee and cocoa on the finish.

Raasay While We Wait, Isle of Raasay, 46% abv

£5.50

From the official first distillery on Isle of Raasay comes this slightly peated whisky that has been matured in Tuscan red wine casks. Shows some stewed fruit with a touch of vanilla and delicate peatiness.

Longrow 18 year old by Springbank, Campbeltown, 46% abv

£9.00

Independent family owned distillery where the whole process is carried out at the site. Longrow is Springbank's peated malt, it shows orange zest, earthy peat, porridge oats, and some spicy and truffle notes.
